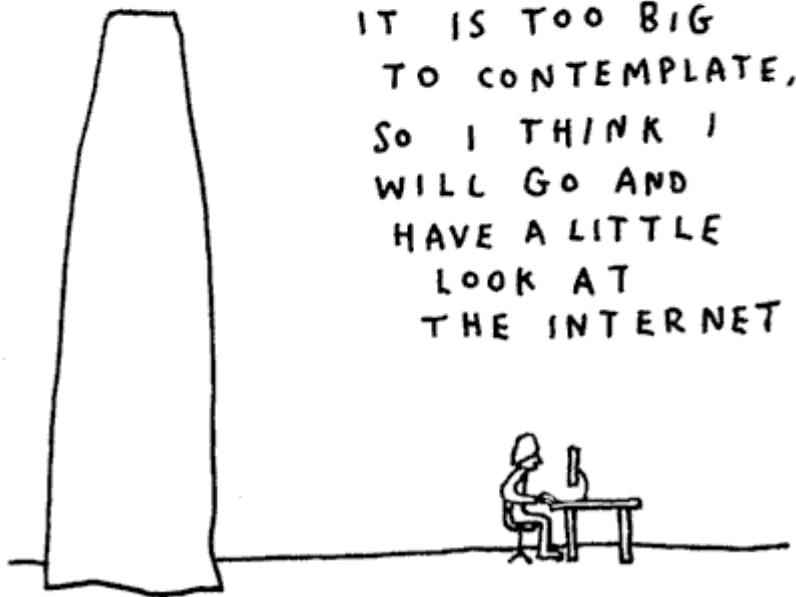

God loves a cheerful giver

Can you give to the church by Standing Order rather than through the pledged envelopes?

It means that the church can rely on a regular income, your giving is not dependent on how you feel that day or on whether or not you are in church.

Currently there are 25 people in the congregation who give a total of #801.00 a month by Standing Order. This makes a weekly average of #7.39 a person.

There are 50 people who give to the church in pledged envelopes. This makes an average of #4.79.

Please can you think of changing your pledged envelope to a standing order.

It cost #50,000 a year to run the church and at the moment we are not covering our costs!

The next Confirmation Service involving people from our parish will be at St Paul's on April 11th. It is the evening before Easter and a great time to be confirmed
